**What is PRAYER
And HOW do we PRAY?**

KEY BIBLE VERSE:

James 5:16 — “Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”

What is PRAYER? — Prayer is talking with God — communicating personally and directly to Him.

Key Verses about PRAYER —

- 1 Timothy 2:1 — (DIFFERENT TYPES OF PRAYER) — “I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;” (S.P.I.T.)
- Philippians 4:6 — (NO FEAR — NOTHING = NO THING) — “Be anxious for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known unto God.”
- Hebrews 11:6 — (PRAY IN FAITH) — “But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.”
- Matthew 7:7-8 — (ASK. SEEK, KNOCK) — “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.
- Matthew 21:22 — (BELIEVE) — “And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.”
- Ephesians 5:20 — (PRAY IN THE NAME OF JESUS) — “giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

HOW TO PRAY — Keys from THE LORD’S PRAYER —

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name.
Thy Kingdom Come. Thy will be done. On earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen
