



BIBLE CHARACTER STUDY OLD TESTAMENT:

#2 — Enoch & The Tower of Babel

Key Bible Verses: ENOCH — Genesis 5:21-24, Hebrews 11:5, Jude 1:14

Genesis 5:21-24 — Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah. After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. And Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

Hebrews 11:5 — By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, “and was not found, because God had taken him”; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Jude 1:14 — Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, “Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints,

Questions about Enoch —

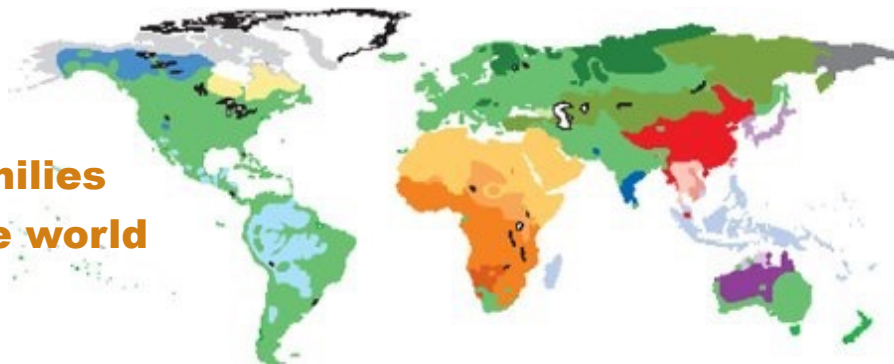
What does it mean to “walk with God”? What does it mean “and he was not, for God took him.”?

Language Families in the world



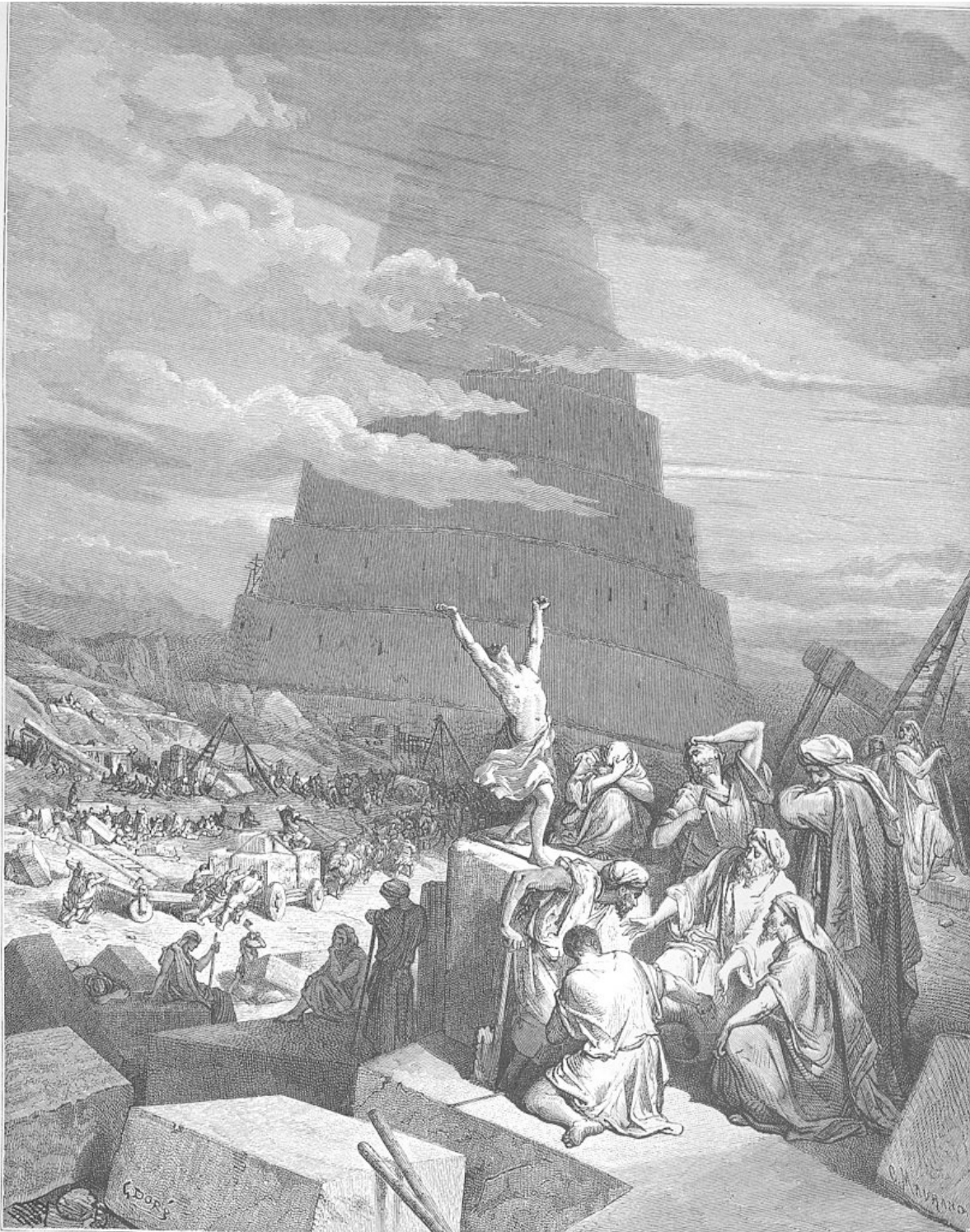
Quotes from Answers in Genesis — THE TOWER OF BABEL

The Tower of Babel (2242 BC) was a post-Flood rebellion against God by Noah’s descendants. God judged them by dividing the single language into multiple language families. As these groups spread out and became isolated, certain features (e.g. skin shade, eye shape) became dominant in certain groups.

Language Families: Secular theories fail to explain the many distinct language families throughout the world. The biblical account of Babel is the only explanation that fits the data.
