

#4 — The Patriarchs: Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob

Key Bible Verses: Genesis 12:1-3


Get out of your country, From your family, And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you. 2. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you, And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3. I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

10 KEY BIBLE FACTS about the Old Testament Patriarchs:

1. ABRAM/ABRAHAM IS CALLED BY GOD: Abraham's wife's name is SARAI/SARAH. God promises them a son.

- 2. IMPATIENCE: Abram takes Sarai's handmaid, HAGAR, to have a child. Abram & Hagar have a son, "ISHMAEL."
- 3. PROMISE FULFILLED: God again promises ABRAHAM & SARAH a son, to be named "ISAAC" (or "laughter").
- 4. HAGAR and son, ISHMAEL are mistreated and they run away. God reveals Himself as "The God who Sees."
- 5. SURRENDER: God calls Abraham to offer Isaac on an altar, a shadow of God offering His son, Jesus on Calvary.
- 6. SACRIFICE: God provides a ram, caught in a thicket to take Isaac's place. God is called "The God who Provides."
- 7. ISAAC & REBECCA: Abraham's servant finds a wife for Isaac. Isaac & Rebecca have twins, JABOB & ESAU.
- 8. BIRTHRIGHT LOST: Esau surrenders his inheritance for a bowl of stew. Jacob earnestly desires God's blessing. 9. JACOB FLEES and works for LABAN who tricks him to marry LEAH the older sister of RACHAEL, whom he loves.
- 10. JACOB'S 12 SONS (through Leah, Rachel and two concubines, Zilpah & Bilhah) become the 12 Tribes of Israel.

Hebrews 11:8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise;
